

Commonly Asked Questions for Admission Requirements – SUSS Full-time Programmes

AN EQUIVALENT OF ANY OF THE BELOW, TOGETHER WITH ACT SCORES

- Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'A' Levels
- OR Polytechnic Diploma from Singapore
- OR International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
- OR NUS High School Diploma
- 1) Can I combine ACT scores from different sittings?

All five sections must be taken in one sitting.

2) Do I need to take Writing section?

The Writing Section is required for admission purposes.

3) How long are ACT scores valid for?

For the purpose of admission, ACT scores are valid for five (5) years.

4) Can I be reimbursed for the cost of the ACTs, if I take them for the purposes of applying for the SUSS full-time programmes?

No, SUSS does not reimburse you for your admission expenses.

5) Where can I find out more about the ACT? When are the next test dates?
