

## Commonly Asked Questions for Admission Requirements – SUSS Full-time Programmes

### POLYTECHNIC DIPLOMA FROM SINGAPORE

- 1) Does my Diploma have to be from a relevant course of study? (eg. Must I have a Diploma in Accountancy in order to apply for the Accountancy programme?)**

No, the diploma obtained does not need to be from a relevant course of study.

- 2) If my Diploma is from a relevant course of study, can I obtain any credit exemptions for the relevant university courses? (eg. I have previously completed a Diploma in Accountancy from a polytechnic in Singapore.)**

SUSS does not give credit exemptions based on previous academic results. Instead, credit waivers of up to 10 credit units (cu) can be obtained based on excellent polytechnic results (GPA  $\geq$  3.5).

Students may also take Challenge Examinations (CEX) for specified Level 1 courses. If you pass these exams, you are granted recognition, thus you do not need to read the courses.

- 3) I have not yet received my last semester's results or official Polytechnic transcript. Can I still apply?**

Yes, you can still apply for admission using your first five semesters of Polytechnic results and your GCE 'O' Level results. You are required to submit your final results/transcript as soon as they are available, as proof of successful completion of your diploma course.
